The Facts

Most at Risk

- Anyone who has been to an affected region in the last 14 days **AND** is experiencing symptoms
- Anyone who has been in close contact with a confirmed or probable case of COVID-19 (Coronavirus) in the last 14 days **AND** is experiencing symptoms

Prevention



Wash

your hands well and often to avoid contamination



Cover

your mouth and nose with a tissue or sleeve when coughing or sneezing and discard used tissue



Avoid

touching eyes, nose, or mouth with unwashed hands



Clean

and disinfect frequently touched objects and surfaces

As a milk supplier, you may be in contact with Strathroy employees and Strathroy contractors. You have a key role to play in our aim to slow the spread of the virus.

Strathroy Dairy's Management Team are constantly monitoring the status of the outbreak based on reputable sources of information including the [HSE](#) and [HPSC](#) websites for Ireland and the [NHS](#) and [HSC](#) for Northern Ireland..

Precautions to prevent or limit the spread of COVID-19 include:

- Good hand hygiene
- Good coughing / sneezing practices
- Use a disinfectant to regularly wipe down surfaces;
- Avoid physical interactions such as shaking hands and maintain a safe distance of at least 1 metre.

DO

Wash you hands or use a hand sanitizer on a regular basis

DO

Cough or sneeze into your upper sleeve. Germs won't spread through your clothing

DON'T

Cough or sneeze into your hands. You'll end up spreading germs to everything you touch

DO

Restrict interaction with the tanker driver to a minimum

DO

Keep all surfaces that drivers need to come in contact with extra clean – Dairy door, tank, tank controls etc.

DO

Inform us if you have been travelling to an affected area or have been infected or could have been in contact with Covid 19

DO

Send samples for testing with drivers. Make sure all sample bottles are clean, dirty sample bottles wont be excepted into the labs

DON'T

Come to the dairy unannounced to bring samples

DO

Keep abreast of advice from the public health authorities
